4. Name, designation, and employment status of authors are also to be mentioned. Papers selected for presentation will be intimated to the author. Authors will register and present the paper in the seminar.
5. Authors should provide a brief biographical note clearly indicating full name, E-mail address, valid contact number, affiliation. Kindly indicate the name of the corresponding author in case of two or more authors. All the seminar related E-mails will be addressed to the corresponding authors only.
6. Accepted and presented papers will be published in book form under ISBN Numbers.
